Monash Residential Services Higher Degree Research Merit Scholarships

Overview

One of Monash Residential Services' (MRS) mission goals is to provide and develop an environment within each location on campus which provides care, support and enrichment for the residential community in academic, cultural, personal, social and recreational matters.

The Monash Residential Services Higher Degree Research Merit Scholarships are provided to further the above divisional mission goal and to promote and engender a high academic environment at all Victorian on-campus residential sites.

Background

No more than ten Monash Residential Services Higher Degree Research Merit Scholarships will be awarded annually to current residents studying at the following Monash faculties and Centres:

- Art and Design
- Arts
- Business and Economics
- Education
- Engineering
- Information Technology
- Law
- Medicine, Nursing and Health Sciences
- Pharmacy
- Science
- Monash University Accident Research Centre (MUARC)

Normally only one award will be made to any single faculty.

Administration and selection

The scholarship will be administered by the Monash Research Graduate School (MRGS):

- an application form will be available at the MRGS website at: <http://mrgs.monash.edu/scholarships/>
- Applications will close on 30 November 2008.
- Ranked applications will be received by MRGS who will consult with MRS and the Pro Vice-Chancellor (Research and Research Training) to determine the scholarship recipients
- Offers must be formally accepted by students
- Payments (rental rebates) will be processed by MRS.

Eligibility

To be eligible applicants must be:

- an Australian or New Zealand citizen or holder of an Australian permanent resident visa or permanent humanitarian visa, and
- a current full time Higher Degree Research student enrolled at a Monash campus in Australia, and

- have been a prior resident with Monash Residential Services in the previous year for at least six months, and
- a current resident with Monash Residential Services

Selection

Selection will be based on:

- the applicant's academic record to date including any publications; and
- and the applicant's position (if applicable) on the Faculty's scholarship Order of Merit list.

Value and Number

\$1000 payable in ten \$100 monthly rental rebates against rent.

Ten (10) scholarships are available each year.

Duration

1 Year

Retention

- Must remain in residency with Monash Residential Services
- Must maintain a full-time enrolment
- Must not be in breach of any current *Monash Residential Services – Conditions of Residency* (refer <http://mrs.monash.edu/on-campus/>)
